

## No course? Why?

Please note: The **no course** policies stated below are subject to change.

There will not be a LIVE course taught when enrollment is below 15 students.

There will not be a LIVE course taught before the February A.C.T. for multiple reasons. When courses were taught for the February test in the past, absenteeism was extremely high. The weeks prior to the February test date include major holidays, the ending of a grading period/semester for most schools, and the likelihood of extreme weather conditions which would necessitate canceling and the difficulties of rescheduling classes. The rate of homework completion was also significantly lower than at other times of the year reducing effectiveness. Finally, at least at the time of this writing, the A.C.T. is not making available their Test Information Service (see other link) for the February test date which is highly recommended for juniors.

There will not be a LIVE course taught before the October A.C.T. Because there is now a September A.C.T. in Ohio, demand for a course for the October test date has decreased significantly. Rather than advertise a course that has a high probability of being canceled due to insufficient enrollment, no class is scheduled.
