

To sophomores and their parents:

Most sophomores do NOT need to be concerned with college admission tests at this time. High-achieving (3.5+) sophomores, however, may want to get an early start. I recommend that she or he sits for the April or June ACT tests. If she or he is *in or has completed* the equivalent of Algebra II and Chemistry, then participating in the ACT SuperCourse is fine. If not, then the student should simply take the ACT without the Writing and pay the extra fee for the Test Information Release.

Some sophomores wish to be involved in post secondary programs as juniors. These students are usually required to have achieved a certain score as a sophomore. If the sophomore has taken the test and fallen short of the required score, he or she should take the ACT SuperCourse before sitting again for the test.
